The NCAA allows student-athletes to work and earn valuable income to assist them with their educational expenses.

There are three different ways a student-athlete can earn income during the year. They are:

There are no limits on the amount a student-athlete may earn from those sources, but there are some restrictions which must be followed in order to avoid an NCAA violation. These are the restrictions:

- The student-athlete may not receive any remuneration for the value or utility that the student-athlete may have for the employer because of the publicity, reputation, fame or personal following he or she has obtained because of athletics ability;
- The student-athlete is to be compensated only for work actually performed;
- The student-athlete is to be compensated at a rate commensurate with the going rate in that locality for similar services;
- The employer and student-athlete will make available for review and inspection, by an authorized representative at the NCAA, or applicable Conference of the University, copies of all documents, earnings statements and other records related to the employment.
- The student-athlete obtained the position through the employer's normal application process.
