Entering 2004-05 Academic Year

### ACADEMIC SUCCESS

We are very proud of our **96% graduation rate for all female student-athletes** who have completed their four years of eligibility (based on the NCAA exhausted eligibility graduation formula).

Many impressive academic achievements occurred in the 2003-2004 academic year ... Here are the tremendous statistics:

- **60% of Texas female student-athletes had a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better** - up 4% from the year prior - and there were **38 perfect 4.0 GPA's** registered during the fall and spring semesters
- the **overall GPA for spring 2004 semester** of all female student-athletes was **3.131, an all-time best**
- the **current cumulative GPA** for UT female student-athletes heading into 2004-05 is **3.123 - best-ever in Texas women's athletics history**

### CHAMPIONSHIPS

Texas has claimed **24 team National Championships**, dating back to the 1981 season. At the conference level, the Longhorns have dominated in the Big 12 and former Southwest Conferences, **winning 115 of a possible 187 league championships**, for an impressive 61.5 winning percentage.

### COACHING SUCCESS

Coaching excellence abounds at The University of Texas. Our women's head coaches have claimed 30 National Coach of the Year honors and 42 Big 12 and Southwest Conference Coach of the Year awards.

#### Current Head Coaches Records/Achievements

##### **BASKETBALL: Jody Conradt, 28 years at Texas**

- 33 years overall as a head coach, record: 847-268 (.760)
- No. 2 all-time winningest coach in women's college basketball history
- No. 4 all-time winningest coach in college men's and women's basketball history
- Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame Inductee (October 1998)
- Women's Basketball Hall of Fame Inductee (June 1999)
- 1 NCAA National Championship
- 13 conference championships
- 5-time Conference Coach of the Year at Texas
- one of only two women's basketball coach in nation to coach three different Margaret Wade Trophy National Player of the Year honorees

##### **DIVING: Matt Scoggin, 10 years at Texas**

- 10 years overall as a head women's & men's diving coach at Texas
- Coached 11 NCAA Individual National Champions
- Three-time NCAA National Women's Diving Coach of the Year
- Four-time Conference Coach of the Year at Texas

##### **GOLF: Susan Watkins, 11 years at Texas**

- 11 years overall as a head coach
- 10 NCAA Top-10 finishes, including three consecutive top 3 finishes (2001-02) and seven consecutive Top-10 finishes (1997-98-present)
- 5 conference championships
- 2-time Big 12 Coach of the Year (2001-02, 2003-03)

##### **ROWING: Carrie Graves, 5 years at Texas**

- Three-time U.S. Olympic rower and named one of 11 of the "Century's Most Notable People in American Rowing" by the 2000-01 American Rowers Almanac
- Led Texas varsity eight boat to NCAA National Championship in 2003 and 2004

##### **TENNIS: Jeff Moore, 22 years at Texas**

- 26 years overall as a head coach, record: 568-202 (.738)
- 2 NCAA National Championships at Texas
- Ranks No. 2 in all-time college women's tennis victories
- 10-time Conference Coach of the Year at Texas
- has earned 27 of a possible 30 conference championships in UT tenure, including 26 consecutive (11 reg. season, 15 tournament titles) from 1988-2000

##### **TRACK & FIELD: Beverly Kearney, 12 years at Texas**

- 16 years overall as a head coach
- 5 NCAA National Championships (four at Texas)
- 20 conference championships
- Three-time NCAA National Coach of the Year at Texas
- 12-time Conference Coach of the Year at Texas

##### **SOCCER: Chris Petrucelli, 5 years at Texas**

- 14 years overall as a head coach; record: 236-58-13 (.790)
- 1 NCAA Championship (in 1995 at Notre Dame), 4 NCAA semifinals
- No. 2 in college women's soccer winning percentage (active coaches)
- Led Texas to first Big 12 regular season championship (2001)

- 8 years overall as a head coach at the varsity level; record: 301-160-1 (.651)
